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Dear Parents/Guardians:

The Mineola UFSD uses the Whitsons Culinary Group to provide their breakfast/lunch programs. I want to remind you that Mineola UFSD is using Nutrikids as its point of sale program. Nutrikids provides access to your child's account on their website MySchoolBucks.com. You will need to create an account in MySchoolBucks.com if you don't currently have one. In order to create an account and/or access the account, you will need your child's student ID number. Your child's ID number is available at each school.

Please review the menu options with your child each day and help him/her make appropriate food choices. In the elementary schools, students order their lunches in the morning and then the cafeteria prepares the lunches based on the daily orders.

Lastly, I want to remind you of the following district policy. Students who owe more than \$10 worth of lunches receive a lunch consisting of a cheese sandwich, milk, fruit and vegetable until the account is paid. If a student owes more than \$10, he/she can't purchase an al a carte item. In order to improve the notification process for the elementary students with negative balances, we send home letters to parents via backpack each week if a child owes more than three lunches. The balances remain with the students from year to year, so if your child owed money in June, please send the money in before September.
