C. Acceptance of Contract for Traffic Study

RESOLUTION #63 – BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Education of the Mineola Union Free School District enter into an agreement with VHB Engineering, surveying and Landscape Architecture, P.C. for a traffic study in connection with the proposed lease of the Cross Street Elementary School to Solomon Schechter Day School.

Discussion: The Superintendent of Schools introduced Mr. Robert Eschbacher of VHB

whose firm will be conducting the traffic study. Mr. Eschbacher discussed the following: his background and expertise in the field of engineering for surveying and landscape architecture; traffic specialty; measure activity level; conduct a comparison for present and future; signage; observation of a typical school day; parents picking up and dropping off; list of recommended changes to take place; parking registrations; term restrictions; coordination with Solomon Schechter and School District;

data gathering; safe efficient flow of traffic; there is an urgency.

The Board of Education raised the following concerns and suggestions: include St. Aidan's into the parking and traffic mix; outcome as to what the district is looking for; need for this study; safety concern; where staff and students will park; train traffic; start times of St. Aidan's and Solomon Schechter coincide; impact on neighborhood; resolving the start time may impact on the dismissal time; late buses; Meagher Place is a small street (Ambulance Depot/Library); idling buses; begin next week with observations; after 3 weeks will return for input in order to finalize report; will report be determining factor if the lease is signed; a request was made to have a spokesperson from CYO and Williston Park Little League attend the next Board Meeting to discuss use of fields; suggestions to include bad weather and Police Reports into the survey; concerns with traffic safety and quality of life, i.e. field usage; possible traffic light; like to see a

compromise; # of staff (60 + 6); controlling the number of Seniors driving; request that St. John's be contacted for students to park there. Legal Counsel suggested amending the Resolution.
